No.PAP/Legis-2(28)/2014/1088. The Punjab Civil Servants (Amendment) Bill 2014, having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of the Punjab on 22 May 2014, and assented to by the Governor of the Punjab on 27 May 2014, is hereby published as an Act of the Provincial Assembly of the Punjab.

THE PUNJAB CIVIL SERVANTS (AMENDMENT) ACT 2014

ACT XIV OF 2014

[First published, after having received the assent of the Governor of the Punjab, in the Gazette of the Punjab (Extraordinary) dated 29 May 2014.]

An Act

further to amend the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974.

Preamble.— Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VIII of 1974) for purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is enacted as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be cited as the Punjab Civil Servants (Amendment) Act 2014.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Insertion of section 22C in Act VIII of 1974.— In the Punjab Civil Servants Act, 1974 (VIII of 1974), after section 22-B, the following section 22C shall be inserted:

“22C. Appointment of Federal civil servants.— (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Government may, by notification, appoint a person to a civil service of the Province or to a post in connection with the affairs of the Province who immediately before the commencement of the Constitution (Eighteenth Amendment) Act, 2010 (X of 2010) was holding a post in connection with the affairs of the Federation and whose services have been transferred to the Province in the wake of the said amendment Act of 2010.

(2) The Government shall, in the prescribed manner, determine the terms and conditions of service of the civil servants appointed under subsection (1) including cadre and seniority.”
